

National Regulatory Regime

- Should include:
 - •Licensing:
 - Application processes
 - Decision-making (and review of decisions)
 - Public participation and consultation
 - •Monitoring and enforcement
 - •Environmental management
 - •Sanctions and penalties for non-compliance
 - •Different bodies: objectives, powers, duties, functions.
 - •How do different Governmental agencies interact?
- Model: application forms, licence terms, report format?
